12. Item 9 (Other Events):

In compliance with the SEC Notice dated 12 March 2020 regarding the filing of current report under Section 17 of the Securities Regulation Code amid Covid-19 Pandemic, we submit herewith a report of the measures which Far Eastern University is undertaking to mitigate the risks of the Covid-19, and the risks and impact of the Covid-19 on its business operation:

A. Measures to mitigate risks:

Screening and Cleaning Measures during School Days:

- Security guards at entrances to hand sanitize everyone entering the campus;
- 100% thermal camera scanning of everyone entering the campus;
- Protocols in place with respect to further screening at isolation rooms for those in excess of body temperature targets following the PSMID (Philippine Society for Microbiology and Infectious Diseases) protocol. This involves physical examination and questionnaire. Should result warrant, this includes delivery to authorized Covid-19 testing centers if necessary. Examining personnel with appropriate protective gear;
- Periodic cleaning and disinfecting of desks, chairs, door handles, comfort rooms, gym facilities, auditorium facilities and meeting places;
- Washrooms provided with soap, hand dryers;
- Postponement or outright cancellation of events with large numbers of people.

Delivering Academic Instruction and Collaboration

- The FEU group of schools has been using the learning management system called Canvas. This system provides course content and the ability of faculty and the students to interact with each other;
- On regular school days, the system is used complementarily with regular class attendance;
- On class suspended days, this system will be used exclusively. Bandwidth requirements have been measured to be modest thus ensuring student and faculty access outside of campus.

Work Accomplishment

- Overall objective is to maintain social distance and to de densify meeting and gathering areas. As such flexible work times and work at home as a result of self quarantine or work suspension is to be supported by the FEU group of schools Office 365 system in place particularly Teams, a video conferencing and chat work system;
- Only work not able to be accomplished remotely will be allowed (such as salary administration);
- When physical meetings required, limit will be to 20 persons in a room with more than ample capacity to maintain a minimum of 2 meters distance from one another.




B. Anticipated Financial Effects:

For Current School Year

- Financial effect is minimal as we are in the final months of the academic calendar;
- Faculty illness to be covered by existing substitute academic team; as mentioned use of Canvas already in place;
- Administrative illness likewise can be covered by the existing personnel.

For Next School Year

- Enrollment levels are uncertain at this time;
- Personnel illness due to the Covid-19 is uncertain at this time.
